Risks



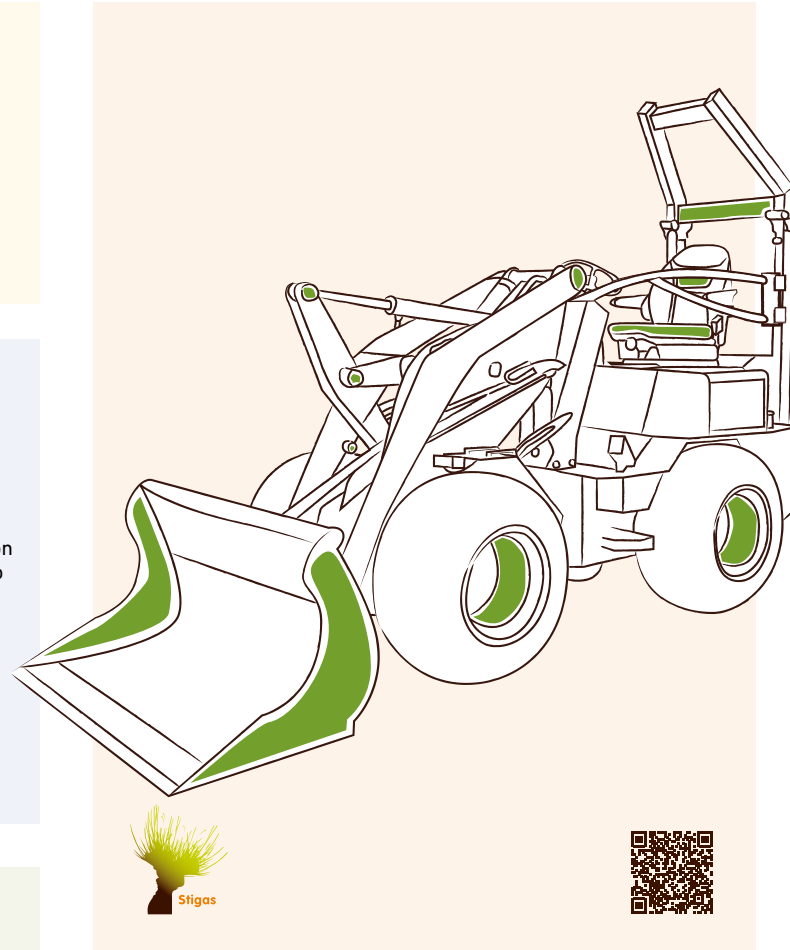
Crush injury caused by loader tipping over



Injury caused by collision or being hit by jib/bucket



Health risks from diesel engine emissions



Protective equipment



Mirror(s), including blind spot mirrors



Acoustic/visual reversing alarms



Hearing protection when there is no cab



Safety frame



Seatbelt



Safety shoes S3



Measures

1. Before starting work



Only use genuine add-on parts



T driving licence required for machinery wider than 1.3 metres



Check floor



Call in the event of emergency or breakdown



Only drive after instructions of use



Check visibility (mirrors clean)

2. During work



Don't drive inside with a diesel machine



Don't allow persons to ride along



Always drive with the lowest possible load



Use a seat belt



Light and sound signals on



Ensure stability when tilting

3. After completing work



Report unsafe situations or accidents and damage/defects to supervisor



Park with the bucket in the lowest position and tilted slightly forwards



Put the loader on the breaker



Remove ignition key



Leave the machine via the stairs, don't jump
